I have a new, reproduction Series 80 / 81 (?) gas tank for sale. I had some idea that I might need it, but after inspection, I discovered that my original is in tip-top condition. It has been sitting on a shelf for a few years and it is now time to sell it along with some other duplicates of duplicate Series 80 parts. The dimensions are 12.5-inches X 11.5-inches X 33-inches. The flanges shown are for mounting on a Series 80 / 81, but the tank may work for other models. The tank has no openings cut for the gas pipe, gas gauge, etc., so your gas pipe, gauge pipe and center controls (if any) will need to be removed from your tank and welded onto this new tank.
